“On motion of Honorable Member Ma. Antonia E. Villegas, seconded by Honorable Member Georgita F. Martinez and Honorable Member Melliemoore M. Saycon, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan

“RESOLVES, To approve Resolution Nos. 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, and 35, all current series, of the Provincial Development Council Executive Committee, and Addendum No. 30 of the Annual Investment Program for Calendar Year 2014, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules, regulations and policies;

“RESOLVES FURTHER, To enact the following Appropriation Ordinance:

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 36  
(Series of 2014)

“Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan that:

Section 1. The sum of ₱400,000.00 representing existing unobligated allotment balance of the allocation of projects funded under the current 20% Economic Development Fund, viz:

- Construction of Multipurpose Pavement  
of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Engineering District DPWH,  
Barangay Malabuhan, Siaton..... ₱ 300,000.00

Construction of Multipurpose Hall at the  
Bayawan City Jail Compound, Bayawan..... ₱ 100,000.00

is hereby appropriated to fund other priority development projects, viz:

Installation of Street Lighting Facilities at Barangay Talalak, Sta. Catalina.....	₱ 50,000.00
Installation of Street Lighting Facilities at Barangay San Jose, Sta. Catalina.....	50,000.00
Installation of Street Lighting Facilities at Barangay Sto. Rosario, Sta. Catalina.....	50,000.00
Installation of Street Lighting Facilities at Barangay Mansagomayon, Sta. Catalina.....	50,000.00
Installation of Street Lighting Facilities at Barangay Nagbinlod, Sta. Catalina.....	50,000.00
Installation of Street Lighting Facilities at Barangay Milagrosa, Sta. Catalina.....	50,000.00
Installation of Street Lighting Facilities at Barangay Bonbonon, Siaton.....	50,000.00
Construction of Water Supply System at Lapay Elementary School, Lapay, Bayawan City.....	50,000.00

Section 2. The sum of ₱150,000.00 representing existing unobligated allotment balance of the allocation of projects funded under the 20% Economic Development Fund for Calendar Year 2012, viz:

Purchase of twenty-nine (29) units Jetmatic Pump.....	₱ 90,000.00
Purchase of Polyethylene Pipes.....	60,000.00

is hereby reverted to the unappropriated balance of the 20% Economic Development Fund; the same amount is likewise appropriated for the Rehabilitation of Water Supply System, Barangay Mampas, Valencia.

Section 3. The amount of ₱600,000.00 representing existing unobligated allotment balance of the allocation for the Completion of Health Center, Barangay San Isidro, Manjuyod, funded under the current 20% Economic Development Fund is hereby appropriated for the Construction of Multipurpose Center, same barangay.

Section 4. The amount of ₱500,000.00 representing existing unobligated allotment balance of the allocation for the Completion of Street Lightings, Barangay North Poblacion, La Libertad, funded under the 20% Economic Development Fund for Calendar Year 2013 is hereby reverted to the unappropriated balance of the 20% Economic Development Fund; the same amount is likewise appropriated for the Construction of Concrete Manholes and Concreting of Barangay Road, same barangay.

Section 5. The amount of ₱100,000.00 representing existing unobligated allotment balance of the allocation for the Construction of Multipurpose Hall, Barangay Magtuhao, Bindoy, funded under the current 20% Economic Development Fund is hereby appropriated for the Improvement of Multipurpose Hall in Sitio Mantahaw, Barangay Nalundan, Bindoy.

Section 6. The amount of ₱50,000.00 representing existing unobligated allotment balance of the allocation for the Construction of Multipurpose Hall, Barangay Pindahan, Tayasan, funded under the current 20% Economic Development Fund is hereby appropriated for the Improvement of Multipurpose Hall, same barangay.

Section 7. The sum of ₱1,800,000.00 representing existing unobligated allotment balance of the allocation of projects funded under the 20% Economic Development Fund for Calendar Year 2012 and 2013, viz:

Rehabilitation and Improvement of Sto. Niño-Balinsasayao Road, San Jose .....	₱ 800,000.00
Concreting of Barangay Janay-janay- Balinsasayao Road, San Jose .....	500,000.00
Concreting of Sto. Niño- Balinsasayao Road, San Jose .....	500,000.00

is hereby reverted to the unappropriated balance of the 20% Economic Development Fund; the same amount is likewise appropriated for the Concreting of Tampi-Siapo Road, San Jose.

Section 8. The amount of ₱1,000,000.00 representing existing unobligated allotment balance of the allocation for the Concreting of Road, Barangay IV (from Engr. Olis to Sitio Maya), Tanjay City, funded under the 20% Economic Development Fund for Calendar Year 2013 is hereby reverted to the unappropriated balance of the 20% Economic Development Fund; the same amount is likewise appropriated for the Improvement of Drainage System of Barangay Poblacion IV, Tanjay City.

Section 9. The amount of ₱1,350,000.00 representing existing unobligated allotment balance of the allocation for the Improvement of East Balabag-Balugo Road, Valencia, under the 20% Economic Development Fund for Calendar Year 2013 is hereby reverted to the unappropriated balance of the 20% Economic Development Fund; the same amount is likewise appropriated for the Improvement of Barangay Road along Del Castillo Lot to East Balabag-Balugo Road, same municipality.


Section 10. Copies of this ordinance shall be forwarded to the Regional Director, Office of Budget and Management, Region VII, Cebu City, for review, pursuant to Section 326 of Republic Act 7160.
